


Weekend Camp Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



When is Weekend camp?

- **July 22-24, 2016**
- Formerly known as "Family Camp" this is a weekend event open to all in our Diocese (minors must be accompanied by an adult family member).
- Check in is at 4:00 pm on Friday. We will be done around noon on Sunday.

What is the cost?

- \$50 per person
- We do have financial assistance available, so please do not let finances get in the way of attending camp.
- Children under 5 may attend free of cost (or at a reduced rate, if you prefer)

Do I have to attend the entire event?

- This camp event is a weekend long, but you can attend for any length. Please note on your registration form, so we can account for food.

Where will we sleep?

- There are many sleeping options, when you register please indicate what you'd prefer and we will do our best to accommodate:
- Cabins - Former platform tents that were made into a-frame cabins. Though the cabins themselves don't have electricity, there is a nice lodge in the area that we can use that does, as does the nearby bathhouses.
- Retreat House - This is our main meeting location, as it's where we'll be preparing food. There are limited beds, so people with limited accessibility will be given preference.
- Bring your Tent or RV/Camper - we have power and water hook-ups! These are located right next to the Retreat House.

I'm a single person, where do I sleep?

- Single people are invited to attend!
- Sleeping arrangements are by family, so if you aren't bringing your own camper or tent, you will most likely be housed with other singles of your gender. If you do make up a family of friends, please note that on the registration form and we will try our best to room you together.

What are the Activities

- There are many free activities offered by us, and also offered by Cran-Hill Ranch, our host site. But there are also some activities they offer for a fee.
- You don't have to do the activities. While there are many activities to choose from, you may prefer to sit around and hang out with friends, both new and old. There are plenty of places and opportunities to do this.
- Bishop Whayne will be joining us for the weekend!

What are the Free Activities

- Offered by us: Arts & Crafts, Games for children, Prayer activities and reading material
- Offered by Cran-Hill: Basketball, Volleyball and Tennis Court, Game Room, Ga Ga Pt, Skate Park, Hiking, Petting Farm, Swimming, Boating, and Fishing

What are the Activities offered for a fee by Cran-Hill (fees differ and not everything may be offered):

- Orienteering, Archery, Riflery and Tomahawks, Zip Line, Rock Climbing, and High Ropes, Bike Rental, Pony Rides, Trail Rides, Hay Wagon Rides, River Tubing and Canoeing
