



Spiritual Coordinator

Job Description

Brief Description

This position cares for spiritual health the same way the nurse cares for physical health. The Spiritual Director is there both for the staff and the campers. This position is not one of a therapist, but rather more of someone to be there & to listen and to pray with and for people.

Qualifications

- This person will be a Christian with a deep and long-standing faith in God and a knowledge that God works in profound ways in the lives of everyone.
- Experience working with people of all ages
- Understanding of Episcopal Eucharist and able to incorporate creative idea and people of all ages
- Can pray extemporaneously
- Is at least 18 years of age
- Has been certified in *Safeguarding God's Children*

Responsibilities

- Works with the staff either individually or during staff meetings to help ensure healthy individual spiritual practices during the week and perhaps teach some new ones that can be used all the time
- Works with campers who are having problems on learning healthy coping mechanisms and spiritual practices
- Intentionally prays for the camp and with and for all members

Line of Authority

- Reports Directly to the Junior Camp & Senior Camp Directors
- As with all members of staff, if any case of abuse is reported it must be brought to the Camp Director.
