Job Descriptions

Brief Description:

Responsible for preparation and execution of formation activities for their designation week. Determine the daily themes based on the annual theme.

Qualifications:

- This person will be a Christian with a deep and long-standing faith in God and a knowledge that God works in profound ways in the lives of everyone.
- Experience working with children at the age of the campers
- Understanding and ability to communicate the lessons of the Bible
- Can lead other people in prayer
- Is at least 18 years of age
- Has been certified in *Safeguarding God's Children*

Responsibilities

- Plan and lead daily formation activities that are interactive, active and meaningful
- Plan the formation activities based on the theme chosen for the year
- Determine number of Cabin Counselors needed for formation, and notify the Junior Camp & Senior Camp Directors
- Supervise Cabin Counselors in assisting campers with formation
- Work with Art Coordinator to plan activities designed around daily/annual theme
